

All children can participate in Rotterdam

Children will learn an awful lot by playing together or by doing sports together. But paying for a club naturally isn't easy for everyone. For example, would your child like to join a football club? My child would like to join a club or have lessons. How does it work?

- 1. Find a contact person at the Rotterdam Sports & Culture Youth Fund. This can be done as follows:
 - a. Ask who can help with your application at school, at the community centre or via a social worker.
 - b. Call the Rotterdam Sport & Culture Youth Fund: 010-4790 137. (Mon to Fri 8-18 hrs, Sat 10-16 hrs)
 - c. Take a look at the map on our website for an address near you: <u>https://jeugdfondssportencultuur.nl/fondsen/rotterdam/#overzichtskaart</u>
- 2. The contact person will deal with your application on your behalf. You will hear whether your application has been approved within three weeks.
- 3. You can then register your child with your chosen club yourself. Your child can then immediately start with the lessons. The Rotterdam Sports & Culture Youth Fund will pay the club's membership fees.
